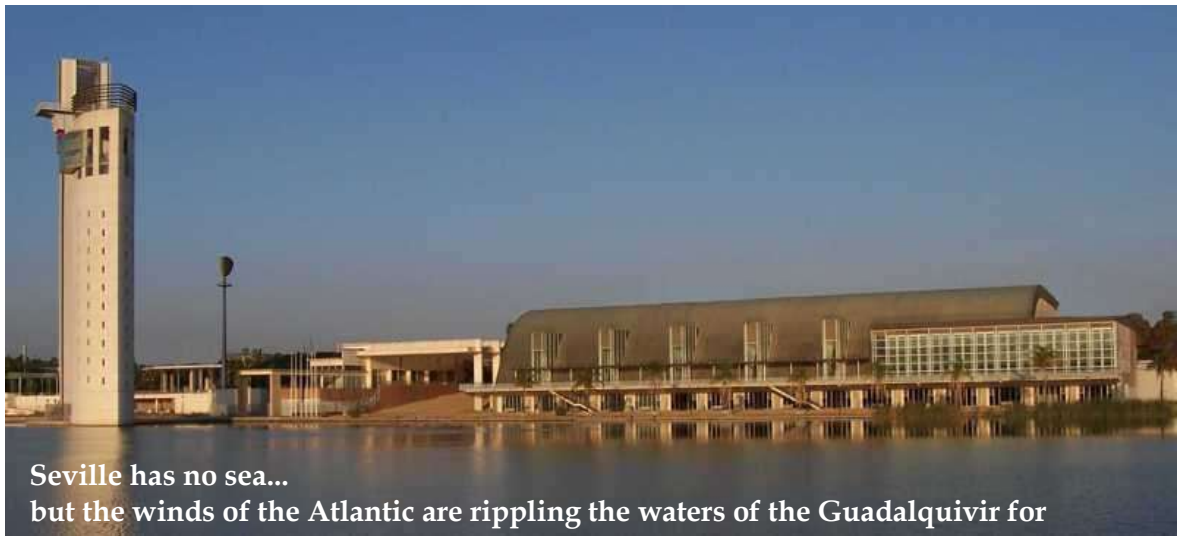

1.- ENVIRONMENT

The Pavilion of Navigation, is situated by the river Guadalquivir, between the bridges of Cartuja and Chapina, unique setting for its proximity to prominent areas of the city as well as to the Cartuja Technological Park, and to the historical or popular Triana.

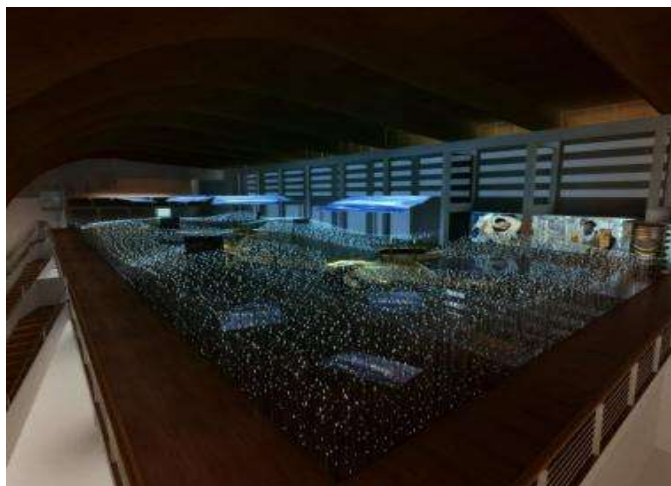


2.- THE BUILDING

Designed by the famous and widely laureate architect Guillermo Vázquez Consuegra (National Architecture Prize in 2005, Andalusia Architecture Prize in 2007, etc.), this unique building, classified by the Government of Andalusia as Historical Heritage, has been adapted to hold the museum of navigation of Sevilla and a great venue. Now, with the new areas and content, the Pavilion has become a first class exhibition center in Andalusia.

The new Pavilion, offers to its public the following areas:

The permanent exhibition: dedicated to the Atlantic navigation. It aims to show the history of navigation starting from the discovery of America and showing the experiences of all the navigators that crossed the oceans, as well as the science, the art of navigation, the life on board and plenty of facts that links navigation to Sevilla.

The Navigation Pavilion also has a complementary building where a school of haute cuisine is located. In front of this, a Viewing Tower is located at the end of the pier by the river Guadalquivir. The height of this Tower, about 60 m, gives it the status of a privileged balcony over the city.

3.- EVENTS AND CONGRESSES

In the period between 1997 and 2008, more than 250 events were celebrated in the Pavilion including conferences, presentations, gala dinners, film, and so on, ranking this activity prominently in the professional panorama of the city.

At present, the new configuration of the Pavilion, contemplates the provision of a specific area, separate from the permanent exhibition, that are dedicated to the celebration of acts and events, where functionality and versatility converge with the uniqueness of the building.

Description of the venue.

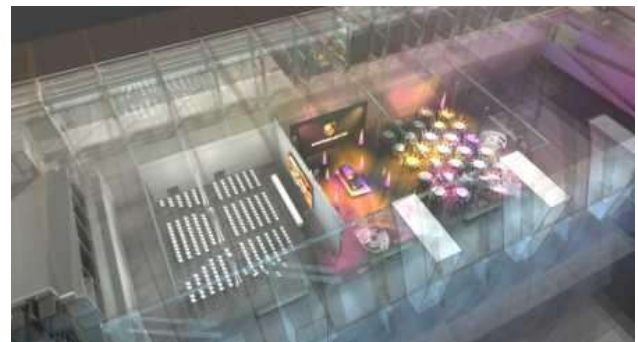
The congresses and conference activities are mainly held in the lower level of the Pavilion.

The entrance is made from the riverfront esplanade. This esplanade is often the starting point of any event especially if it requires a outdoor space for receiving attendees.



Inside the Pavilion, a spacious foyer provides an alternative to the outdoor spaces in case the weather is not adequate.

From the foyer we may access to the Multipurpose rooms. These rooms are spaces with neutral design, of more than 6 meters high, which are configured through mobile panels that give them great versatility and adaptability to the needs of each event.



By removing the movable panels it is possible to join each room with the adjacent and all of them with the entrance foyer. Only this configuration, with all the panels removed, reveals the presence of 12 columns supporting the platform of the upper level of the pavilion dedicated to the permanent exhibition.



Alongside the Multipurpose Rooms you will find La Plaza, a space with large room (1,000 m²) that allows accommodate conference activities and corporate events if the activity that takes place is compatible with the normal operation of the permanent exhibition of the Pavilion,

Technical equipment.

Spaces are equipped with electric power supply and telecommunications facilities for holding events with usual.

It has a network of pipes under ground that enables lying hidden wiring. It also has ceiling mount points for lighting.

- Recommended types of events: professional events, corporate and institutional.
- Thematizations Ideas: The availability of the visit to the Permanent Exhibition, references to the world of sailing, water, river Guadalquivir, the possibility of enjoying the viewing tower or boat access to the Pavilion, are complements and ideas for event customizing. There is no exclusivity as to caterers / catering.
- It features fully equipped and independent logistics and preparation of catering kitchens.
- Service area for loading and unloading goods.

- Private boat docking point.
- Bus stop (C1 y C2) near the Pabellón.
- Bicycle lane.
- 12 km from Airport and 5 km from railway station (AVE Santa Justa).
- It has parking nearby with large capacity for approximately 100 vehicles
- Handicapped accessibility.
